ePRI4ALL moves forward!

Result 3: We created a MOOC course!

In early November 2023, the Italian partners (UNIMORE) launched the first Pilot-Run of the MOOC: School Leaders Inclusive Digital and Learning. A three-week course (12 hours of learning in total), totally free of charge and with a dedication of 3hs per week.



The aim of the course is to further strengthen the professional continuing development of head teachers and school leaders in online and inclusive education, providina knowledge, skills and competences in management and quidance; and skills to meet the needs of learners.

Result 4: We launched a multilingual mobile APP!

What is it?

It is a game-based APP, which aims to provide effective training for primary school leaders, educators, trainers and education facilitators.

The APP is an innovative digital training tool that combines mobile learning and game-based learning with gamification.

Why M-learning?

With technology omnipresent, the high number of mobile phone users, the fast pace of life and the need for more flexible solutions, mlearning optimises the resources available today. Moreover, it is suitable for acquiring knowledge in a systematic way, giving immediate access to small or independent pieces of information.

Coming soon...

In late November and early December 2023. the consortium launched four National Workshops, one for each country of the consortium (Almeria; Reggio Emilia; Athens and Rzeszów), an event to introduce education leaders, education students and kev stakeholders to the Open Educational Resources (OERs); the MOOC course and the mobile APP, which aims to train leaders in the field of education and e-Inclusion.

Durina this time, the consortium also decided to launch in early February 2024 the second Pilot-Run of the MOOC, or rather the second round of enrolment for all those who wish to continue training in this line (now with translations into several languages). Also, in the last month, the partnership launched the multilingual APP (Spanish; English; Polish; Italian and Greek).
